
## MetroQuest Survey





- •Mebane Park and Ride lot (lots)


Projects that the attendees would oppose or have concerns with:

  - •Mebane Commuter Rail
  - •I-40/I-85-NC 61 Interchange area (truck traffic/ Love's at this interchange)
  - Mebane SPOT 6.0 highway projects

# Existing + Committed 2045 Scenario






### Operations & Safety Scenario 2045 Conditions



## PM Peak Congestion based on afternoon peak travel speeds, 2018 HERE cell phone data


• PM peak congestion critical on US 70 and on major arterials connecting US 70 and I-40

### **Roadway Scoring Components**






## Fiscally-Constrained Draft Project Map





Focus on operations improvements


Half of Roadway projects are modernization (e.g. medians, turn lanes)

Bicycle, Pedestrian, Transit include sidewalks, new buses, Park-and-Rides, and paths








